Finally, experience Pokhara, Nepal's most scenic lake city surrounded by Himalayan peaks, waterfalls, caves, and adventure activities, including sunrise views from Sarangkot overlooking the Annapurna and Dhaulagiri ranges.

Destinations Profile

Kathmandu – Cultural Capital of Nepal
Altitude: 1,400 m (4,593 ft)
Temperature: 10°C – 29°C

Kathmandu is not just a city – it is an open-air living museum of Hinduism and Buddhism blended together. As a foreign traveler, you immediately feel the contrast between modern streets and ancient spirituality existing side by side.

Walking through Kathmandu feels like stepping into a different era – incense smoke rising from temple courtyards, monks in maroon robes chanting prayers, and centuries-old palaces standing proudly in the heart of the city.

Activities & Experience:

Temple rituals at Pashupatinath (Hindu cremation traditions observation area) – witnessing one of the oldest spiritual practices in the world along the holy Bagmati River

Buddhist prayer wheel experience at Boudhanath – walking with pilgrims as giant white stupa dominates the skyline

Hilltop sunrise and panoramic views at Swayambhunath – where monkeys roam freely and Kathmandu valley spreads beneath golden light

Royal palace history at Kathmandu Durbar Square – where ancient kings once ruled Nepal

Cultural walking tour in Thamel – vibrant streets filled with handicrafts, cafes, and global travelers



Bhaktapur – Medieval Heritage City

Altitude: 1,401 m (4,596 ft)

Temperature: 10°C – 29°C

Bhaktapur feels like a **time capsule of medieval Nepal**, where modern vehicles disappear and stone-paved alleys lead you into centuries-old civilization.

For foreign travelers, it is one of the most authentic **“old-world Europe-like medieval experiences” in Asia** – but with Nepali soul, temples, and living traditions.

Activities & Experience:

Live pottery making at Pottery Square – clay wheels turning as artisans shape centuries-old traditions

Walk through brick-paved medieval alleys – where every corner looks like a movie set from ancient times

Traditional Newari culture observation – locals still wearing traditional attire during festivals

Local tasting of Juju Dhau (King Yogurt) – served in clay pots, a royal delicacy of ancient kings

Artisan wood carving workshops – intricate windows and temple decorations handcrafted by masters

Lalitpur (Patan) – City of Fine Arts

Altitude: 1,350 m (4,429 ft)

Temperature: 10°C – 29°C

Patan is often described as a **living gallery of art and spirituality**, where every building carries centuries of craftsmanship.

Foreign visitors are amazed by how deeply art is integrated into everyday life – from temples to household courtyards.

Activities & Experience:

Metal statue making workshops – observe artisans using ancient lost-wax casting techniques

Ancient palace courtyards exploration – peaceful squares filled with history and silence

Buddhist monastery visits – monks practicing meditation in centuries-old sanctuaries

Thangka painting cultural observation – sacred Buddhist art created with extreme precision





Chitwan – Wildlife Safari Destination

Altitude: 150 m (492 ft)

Temperature: 12°C – 38°C

Chitwan feels like stepping into an **African-style jungle safari but in South Asia**, filled with dense forest, rivers, and raw wilderness.

For foreign tourists, it is often the most exciting contrast after cultural cities – suddenly replaced by elephants, rhinos, and jungle sounds at night.

Activities & Experience:

Jeep safari deep inside jungle trails – searching for rhinos in tall elephant grass

Canoe ride on Rapti River (crocodile spotting) – floating quietly past basking gharials and birdlife

Bird watching tour – over 500 species in natural wetlands

Jungle walk with naturalist guide – tracking animal footprints and learning ecosystem secrets

Tharu cultural dance program – fire-lit performances with drums and storytelling

Wildlife spotting: rhino, deer, wild boar, crocodiles, birds, tiger (rare)

Lumbini – Birthplace of Lord Buddha

Altitude: 150 m (492 ft)

Temperature: 10°C – 40°C

Lumbini gives an overwhelming feeling of **peace and spiritual silence**, unlike any tourist destination in the world.

Foreign visitors often describe it as a place where time slows down completely.

Activities & Experience:

Maya Devi Temple pilgrimage walk – standing at the exact birthplace of Buddha

Sacred Garden meditation – peaceful silence surrounded by monks and pilgrims

Ashoka Pillar historical site – ancient inscription from Emperor Ashoka

Monastery zone exploration (global Buddhist countries) – Japan, Thailand, Myanmar, China architecture

Silent meditation experience – walking slowly through spiritual pathways





Tilaurakot – Ancient Kingdom Site
Altitude: 120 m (394 ft)
Temperature: 10°C – 40°C

Tilaurakot feels like a **forgotten ancient civilization being rediscovered**, where archaeology meets legend.

Activities & Experience:

- Ancient palace ruins exploration** – believed to be Prince Siddhartha’s childhood palace
- Historical city gate remains** – ancient defense structures still visible
- Archaeological interpretation tour** – guided explanation of excavation findings
- Buddhist history storytelling** – connecting myth and historical research

Pokhara – Lake City of Himalayas
Altitude: 822 m (2,697 ft)
Temperature: 8°C – 32°C

Pokhara is often described by foreign travelers as the **most beautiful relaxing city in Asia**, combining lakes, mountains, and adventure.

The atmosphere is calm, romantic, and breathtaking – especially when snow peaks reflect on the lake.

Activities & Experience:

- Phewa Lake boating with mountain reflection** – calm water mirroring Himalayan peaks
- Tal Barahi Temple visit (island temple)** – spiritual site in the middle of the lake
- Devi’s Fall & Gupteshwor Cave exploration** – underground river systems and waterfalls
- Lakeside walking & café experience** – live music, international cafes, sunset views
- Optional adventure: paragliding, zipline, ultralight flight** – flying over mountains like a bird-Short scenic hike through traditional mountain villages & Photography opportunities with snow-capped peaks in Australian Base Camp.





Australian Base Camp – Panoramic Himalayan Viewpoint
Altitude: 2,060 m (6,759 ft)
Temperature: 5°C – 20°C

Australian Base Camp is one of the **most scenic Himalayan viewpoints near Pokhara**, attracting trekkers and nature enthusiasts seeking breathtaking mountain panoramas and peaceful natural surroundings.

Activities & Experience:

Sunrise and sunset over Annapurna South, Hiunchuli & Machhapuchhre – spectacular Himalayan color transformation

Photography session – capturing panoramic mountain vistas and picturesque landscapes

Nature walk through rhododendron forests – experiencing the beauty of the Annapurna foothills

Cultural interaction with local villages – enjoying authentic Himalayan hospitality and rural life

Relaxation at the viewpoint – overlooking the majestic Annapurna range and Pokhara Valley below





DETAILED DAY-WISE ITINERARY

DAY 01: ARRIVAL IN KATHMANDU

Altitude: 1,400 m | Temperature: 10°C – 29°C
Distance: Airport → Hotel approx. 5–10 km (30–40 min)
Arrival, hotel transfer, briefing, leisure walk in Thamel.

DAY 02: KATHMANDU HERITAGE TOUR

Altitude: 1,400 m | Temperature: 10°C – 29°C
Distance: Local sightseeing approx. 20–40 km total travel
**Visit Pashupatinath, Boudhanath, Swayambhunath, Durbar Square.
Cultural exploration and local interaction.**

DAY 03: BHAKTAPUR & PATAN TOUR

Altitude: 1,350–1,401 m | Temperature: 10°C – 29°C
Distance: Kathmandu → Bhaktapur → Patan approx. 30–45 km total
Medieval city walk, pottery experience, artisan workshops, temples visit.

DAY 04: KATHMANDU → CHITWAN

Altitude: 1,400 m → 150 m | Temperature: 10°C – 29°C → 12°C – 38°C
Distance: Approx. 160–170 km (6–7 hrs drive)
Scenic drive, Tharu village visit, sunset at Rapti River.

DAY 05: CHITWAN SAFARI DAY

Altitude: 150 m | Temperature: 12°C – 38°C
Distance: Inside park travel approx. 20–50 km (safari routes)
Jeep safari, canoe ride, jungle walk, bird watching, wildlife spotting.



DAY 06: CHITWAN CULTURAL EXPERIENCE

Altitude: 150 m | Temperature: 12°C – 38°C

Distance: Local village travel approx. 10–25 km

Tharu village lifestyle, farming interaction, nature exploration.

DAY 07: CHITWAN → LUMBINI

Altitude: 150 m | Temperature: 12°C – 38°C → 10°C – 40°C

Distance: Approx. 150–170 km (5–6 hrs drive)

Scenic Terai drive, relaxation.

DAY 08: LUMBINI TOUR

Altitude: 150 m | Temperature: 10°C – 40°C

Distance: Local sightseeing approx. 10–20 km

Maya Devi Temple, sacred garden, monasteries, meditation.

DAY 09: TILAUROKOT EXCURSION

Altitude: 120 m | Temperature: 10°C – 40°C

Distance: Lumbini → Tilaurakot approx. 25–30 km (1 hr drive)

Ancient ruins, archaeological exploration, historical storytelling.

DAY 10: LUMBINI → POKHARA

Altitude: 150 m → 822 m | Temperature: 10°C – 40°C

Distance: Approx. 200–210 km (6–7 hrs drive)

Scenic drive, lakeside sunset walk.



DAY 11: POKHARA, SARANGKOT AND AUSTRALIAN BASE CAMP

Altitude: 822 m → 2,060 m

Temperature: 8°C – 32°C → 5°C – 25°C

Distance: Sarangkot approx. 20 km + Australian Base Camp

Early morning sunrise excursion to Sarangkot followed by a scenic journey to Australian Base Camp. Enjoy breathtaking Himalayan panoramas, traditional villages, and peaceful natural surroundings before returning to Pokhara.

DAY 12: POKHARA (Phewa lake, Boating, Peace Pagoda Tour & Local Market Explore)

Altitude: 822 m | Temperature: 8°C – 32°C

Distance: Local sightseeing approx. 10–30 km

Boating, temple visit, adventure sports, café relaxation.

DAY 13: POKHARA → KATHMANDU

Altitude: 822 m → 1,400 m

Temperature: 8°C – 32°C → 10°C – 29°C

Distance: Approx. 200–210 km (6–8 hrs drive)

Scenic drive, shopping evening.

DAY 14: LEISURE & FAREWELL DINNER

Altitude: 1,400 m | Temperature: 10°C – 29°C

Distance: Local movement approx. 5–15 km

Shopping, free exploration, cultural farewell dinner.

DAY 15: DEPARTURE

Altitude: 1,400 m | Temperature: 10°C – 29°C

Distance: Hotel → Airport approx. 5–10 km

Airport transfer and final departure.
